# ARP Act - Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Reporting (HEERF III) Report and Disclosure for March 2022

- University of Missouri Kansas City acknowledges it signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the original Certification and Agreement form on 04/16/2020 under the CARES Act section 18004(a)(1), and assures that the funds will and have been used to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 2. The Total Amount of funds UMKC received from the US Department of Education to fund HEERF III emergency grants is \$11,423,023.
- 3. The Total Amount of HEERF III funds awarded as of 3/31/2022 is \$8,357,000.
- 4. We estimate that 20,793 students are eligible to be considered for the HEERF III funds.
- 5. The total number of students who have received HEERF III funds as of 3/31/2022 is 6,813.
- 6. UMKC used the following methods for determining eligibility for HEERF III funding:
  - a. Eligibility Requirements
    - i. Enrolled in the Spring 2021 term, Summer 2021 term, or Fall 2021 Term
    - ii. Priority to students with financial need
    - iii. Complete a Federal HEERF III Emergency Grant application
  - b. Award Amount determined based upon a student's need as calculated by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or through case by case review to adjust a student from one category to a higher one based on other need information or other extenuating circumstances. This may include students working with the basic needs coordinator utilizing the food pantry or in some other capacity or based on other extenuating circumstances.

- c. Students have the option to indicate if they want the grant to apply first to their student bill or be sent to them as check or direct deposit through the application process
- d. Awards were distributed on a first come first serve basis and due to the high volume of applicants, the application was closed 10/8/2021 to allow processing time for review of applications and posting of awards.



### FINANCIAL AID ADJUSTMENTS FOR SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

If you or your family's financial situation has changed significantly from what is reflected on your federal income tax return (for example, if you've lost a job or experienced a drop in income), you may be eligible for adjusted financial aid.

First, fill out the FAFSA and submit it to UMKC using our school code: **002518**. This information will be used to review your eligibility for federal aid.

Once you have completed the FAFSA or if you've already submitted it, we may be able to adjust the information to reflect your current financial circumstances. If changes to your family's financial situation occurred within the current academic year, you can submit a **Special Circumstances Appeal** to see if you qualify for additional aid.
