2023-2024 TEACH Grant Application

The Federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant is awarded through the UMKC Financial Aid & Scholarships Office to students who are completing, or intend to complete, teaching coursework and who agree to serve for a minimum of four years as a full-time, highly-qualified, high-need field teacher in a school that serves low-income students.

Students awarded the TEACH Grant are required to complete four years of qualified teaching service within eight years of completing their course of study for which the TEACH Grant was received. Failure to meet this or any other requirement of the TEACH Grant will result in the grant converting into a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan, with interest accrued and capitalized from the date of original grant disbursement.

To apply for the award UMKC students must:

- Complete a 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FASFA) at: <u>https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</u> (UMKC school code: 002518)
- Meet qualifying academic achievement requirements (generally, scoring above the 75th percentile on a college admissions test or maintaining a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25). Current teachers, former teachers, and retirees are not required to meet either of these requirements.
- Be a degree seeking undergraduate student seeking their first bachelors or a degree seeking graduate student. Students seeking a post-baccalaureate certification or a second undergraduate degree are not eligible.
- Enroll in coursework necessary to complete a teacher certification in a high-need field (NOTE: You are not required to be admitted to the School of Education to qualify for the TEACH Grant).
- Complete TEACH Grant Entrance Counseling.
- Complete an Agreement to Serve or Repay from the Department of Education.

(Students will NOT be able to sign the agreement until the student has been awarded)

• Be enrolled in at least three (3) credit hours.

Award Amounts:

Due to automatic federal budget cuts, known as the "sequestration," for any TEACH Grant first disbursed on or after Oct. 1, 2022, and before Oct. 1, 2023, the maximum award of \$4,000 is reduced by 5.7 percent (\$228), resulting in a maximum award of:

To fulfill the TEACH Grant Agreement to Service Requirements, a recipient must:

- Serve as a full-time highly qualified teacher in a low-income school in a high-need field as listed in the
 Nationwide List for the state in which you will be teaching the majority of classes for at least four years within
 eight calendar years of leaving the program for which you received the TEACH Grant. High-Need fields are these
 specific fields: bilingual education and English Language Acquisition, foreign language, mathematics, reading
 specialist, science, and special education. For others, and to access the nationwide list of high-need field areas

- Write to the Secretary of Education (within 120 days of completing or otherwise leaving the program of study for which the TEACH Grant was received) confirming that you are employed as a full-time teacher in accordance with the terms of the TEACH Grant, or you are not yet employed as a full-time teacher but intend to meet the terms of the TEACH Grant service agreement.
- Respond promptly to any requests for information or documentation from the U.S. Department of Education.
- Submit upon completion of each year of teaching service, documentation of the service in the form of a certification by a chief administrative officer of the school.
- Comply with all other terms, conditions, and requirements that the Secretary of Education determines to be necessary.

Failing to meet any of the terms above will result in the TEACH Grant funds you received converting into a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford loan, with interest accrued and capitalized from the date of original TEACH Grant disbursement(s). Once this grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to a grant.
