Summer 2022 Work-Study Quick Guide

- **The summer 2022 Work-Study period is June 6, 2022-July 29, 2022.**
- Students must have a separate Federal Work-Study (FWS) award for the summer 2022 period in order to work. Having had Work-Study during the Academic Year **does not guarantee a summer Work-Study award or job** and requesting it does not guarantee an award. Due to federal funding the number of summer Work-Study positions may increase or decrease compared to the Academic Year.
- Summer awarding is done manually so a request for summer financial aid and for a summer Work-Study award must be submitted to the Financial Aid and Scholarships Office in writing. An online [Summer Aid Request](#) was emailed to all students on March 4, 2022 with information about how to request summer financial aid and summer work-study.
- Students must be enrolled at least **half-time** in order to participate in the Work-Study program.
 - 6 credit hours for undergraduate students
 - 5 credit hours for graduate students
- Students must also be **meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)** in order to qualify for UMKC's Work-Study program in any given semester. If the student turns in an appeal and is given a contract for one semester, the student under the terms of the contract is **not** eligible to participate in the Work-Study program.

- The last day of the **spring 2022** semester is **Friday, May 13, 2022**. Students with a spring 2022 Work-Study position must stop working on this day.
- Students who are working a **spring 2022** Work-Study position and have a **summer 2022** Work-Study award may work through the break between the end of spring 2022 semester and the beginning of the summer 2022 semester: **May 14-June 5, 2022**. Those earnings will be charged to their summer 2022 Work-Study award.
 - **Half-time enrollment must be met for both spring 2022 semester and summer 2022 semester before the student is eligible to work during this break period.**
- Students with only a **summer 2022** Work-Study award may not start working their summer Work-Study position until **Monday, June 6, 2022** and must stop working on **Friday, July 29, 2022**.
- Students who have a **summer 2022** Work-Study award and a **fall 2022** Work-Study award may work during the break between the end of the summer 2022 semester and the beginning of the fall 2022 semester: **July 30-August 21, 2022**. Those earnings will be charged to their fall 2022 Work-Study award.
 - **Half-time enrollment must be met for both summer 2022 semester and fall 2022 semester before the student is eligible to work during this break period.**

- Students offered a **summer 2022** Work-Study award must accept the award offer on Pathway before they have access to the summer Work-Study Job Postings in [Handshake](#).
 - *Pathway > Self-Service > Campus Finances > Accept/Decline Awards > Aid Year 2022*
- Summer 2022 Work-Study positions will becoming available in **Handshake** (<https://career.umkc.edu/>) on **Wednesday, May 4, 2022**:
 1. Go to [Handshake](#)
 2. Click the "Log In" link under the current student section.
 3. Enter your UMKC Username & Password under **UMKC Student Only Login****
 4. To find work study positions select **Career Center > Resources > Work-Study Jobs >** and follow the **link** to the Work Study Jobs portal
 5. Enter your UMKC Username & Password for a second time.
 6. Listing of all Summer 2022 Federal Work-Study Job openings.*
